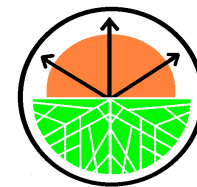


Undoing Racism™ / Community Organizing Workshop by the People's Institute for Survival and Beyond

Virginia Polytechnic's National Capital Region is located in historic Old Town Alexandria at: 1021 Prince Street, Alexandria, VA, 22314

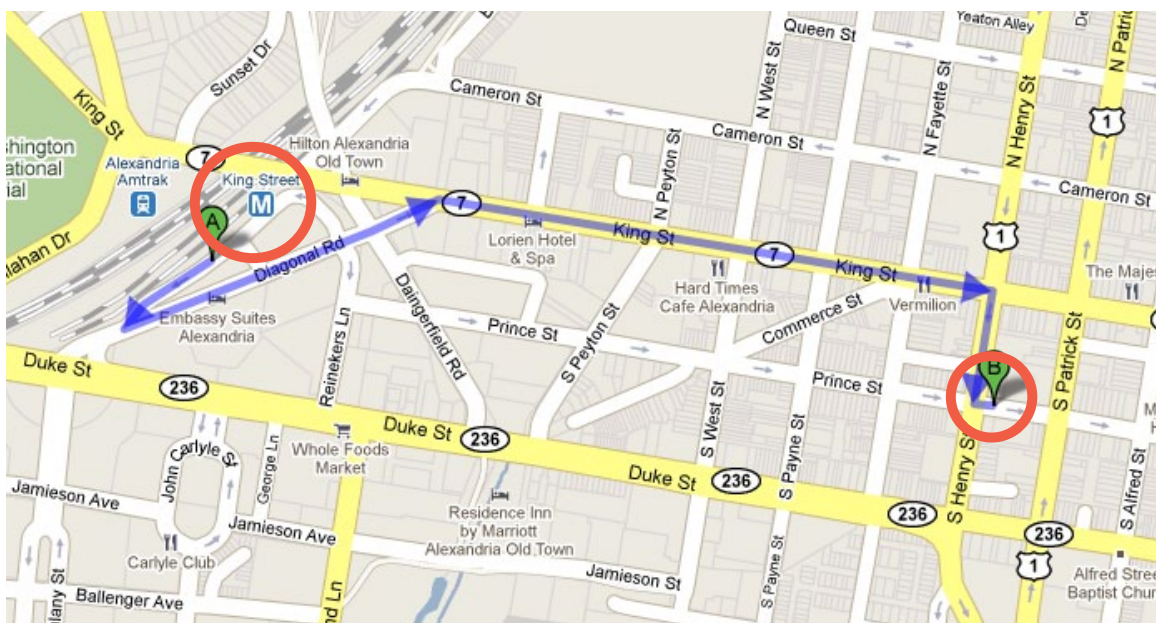
Old Town Alexandria is located along the Western bank of the Potomac River, approximately 6 miles south of downtown Washington, D.C.

The university is accessible via metro. Public parking spaces are also available.

By Metro:

Both the Yellow and Blue lines stop at the king street metro.

Metrorail stations open at 5 a.m. on weekdays and at 7 a.m. on weekends.



By Bus:

DASH is the local bus service operated by the Alexandria Transit Company.

Ride the Free King Street Trolley and get off at the King and Patrick stop. The free trolley departs from the King Street Metro every :10, :30, and :50 minutes after each hour.
